

Faith Talk - The Beginning Matters: Redemption Matters

Genesis 3:8-24

August 2, 2026

As you gather around the table as family or friends, discuss the following questions related to today's message.

1. When Adam and Eve sinned, their first instinct was to hide and shift blame rather than take responsibility. Why do you think we naturally respond the same way today, and what does God's pursuit of Adam teach us about His character and love?
2. Genesis 3 shows that sin affects every part of life—our relationships, our work, creation, even leading to death. Which consequence of sin do you see most clearly in our world and in your own life? How does the gospel give hope in the middle of that brokenness?
3. The message highlighted Genesis 3:15 as the first promise of the gospel, pointing to Jesus as the One who crushes the serpent. How does seeing God's plan of redemption begin so early in Scripture deepen your confidence in His faithfulness?
4. The message traced the Bible's story from the Garden of Eden, to the garden of Jesus' burial and resurrection, to the New Creation where God's people dwell with Him forever. How should living with that future hope shape the way we face temptation, suffering, and everyday life today?
